 1. The Class B Units in Plains AAP, L.P. represent a profits interest. 25% of the Class B Units will become earned (entitled to receive distributions) when Plains AI American Pipeline, L.P. ("PAA") generates DCF on a trailing four-quarter basis of \$2.50 per unit. The remaining 75% of the Class B units are already earned. The Class B Units are subject to a call right in the event Reporting Person's employment is terminated under certain circumstances prior to December 31, 2022. If Reporting Person remains employed after such date, the Class B Units will be deemed to have vested.

 2. Reporting Person has the right to convert his vested Class B Units into Class A Units in Plains AAP, L.P. and Class B Shares in Plains GP Holdings, L.P. at a conversion ratio of approximately 0.941:1. Following any such conversion, the resulting Class A Units and Class B Shares are exchangeable for Class A Shares of PAGP on a one-for-one basis.
